

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Only Baptist churches in Queensland are eligible to apply for this grant.
2. The grant amount must be used and applied solely for the purpose of the project stated in the Application Form.
3. As the number of responses can be high, not every application that meets the selection criteria will necessarily receive a grant.
4. Expenditure of the funds granted must be completed by 30 June 2020.
5. The Grantee will provide to Carinity an income and expenditure report verified by the church treasurer no later than the 31 July 2020.
6. The Grantee must also provide a brief final report on the project outcomes by 31 July 2020. The purpose of the report is to outline outcomes achieved and other relevant information.
7. The Grantee agrees to cooperate with Carinity for marketing and promoting purposes including providing information and photographs.
8. If, at any time, the stated purpose of the project is no longer possible and cannot be completed in the manner described in the application and proposal submitted to Carinity, the Grantee must advise Carinity of the inability to complete the stated purpose and any remaining unspent amount of the grant must be returned to Carinity within one month of this becoming apparent.
9. Carinity may agree to a variation in the purpose and project provided that variation still meets the initial selection criteria.
10. The Grantee must keep and maintain adequate insurance (including public liability insurance) for the activities carried out by the Grantee in relation to this project, against any claims for loss or damage to property and injury or death to persons.
11. Carinity's financial assistance to the project must be acknowledged, as outlined in the Funding Acknowledgement Guidelines, regardless of the amount of funding, for the duration of the project.
12. Carinity reserves the right to a refund of the grant amount if the Grantee does not meet these terms and conditions.
